

**Service in Massachusetts will remember Flight 11 victim

As the nation mourns the thousands presumed dead in the terrorist attacks last week, family and friends will remember Plaistow resident Carol Flyzik at a memorial service today.

Flyzik was one of the 92 passengers aboard American Airlines Flight 11 who died when hijackers crashed the plane into one of the World Trade Center towers in New York City.

Flyzik, 40, is the latest New Hampshire victim of the terrorist attack to be remembered.

The service begins at 4 p.m. at Georgetown Congregational Church on Andover Street in Georgetown, Mass. Flyzik was raised in Georgetown.

She was on her way to Los Angeles for a business trip when the plane crashed. Flyzik was the supervisor of marketing support for Medical Information Technology Inc. of Westwood, Mass., a company that sells medical software to health care organizations.
